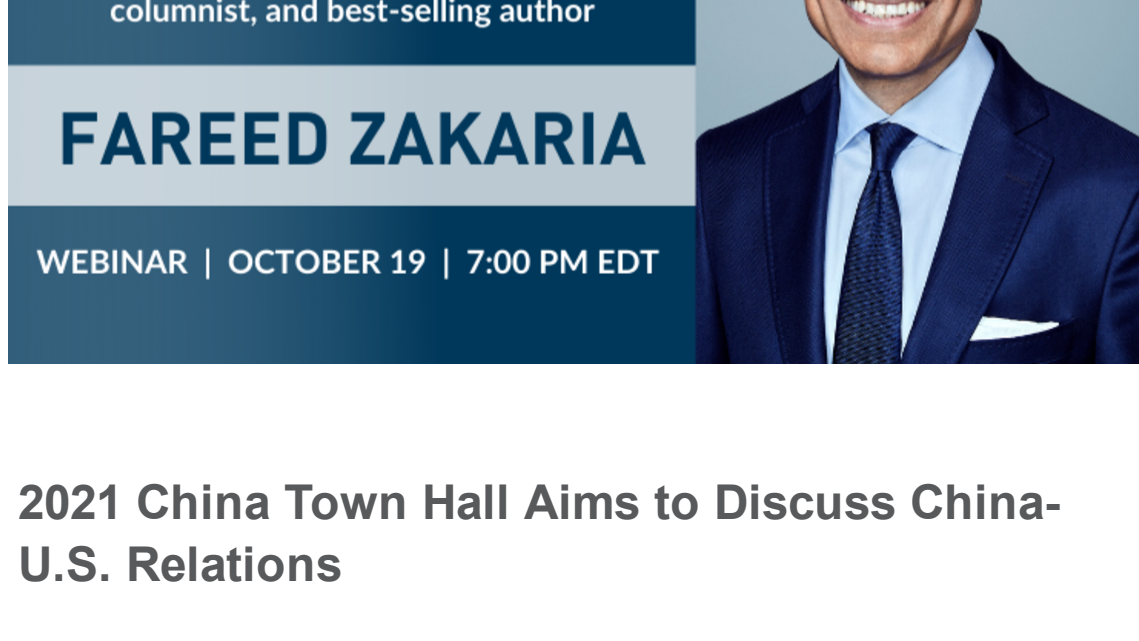


International Festival Recap

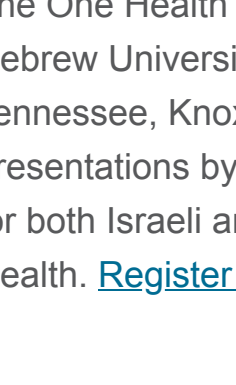

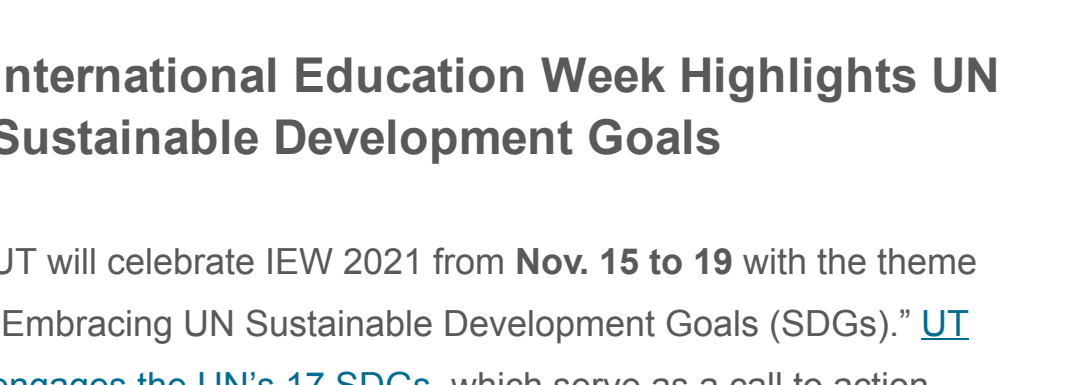


One Health Workshop

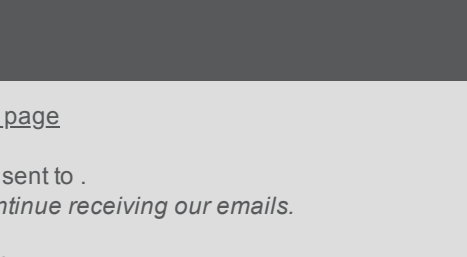
