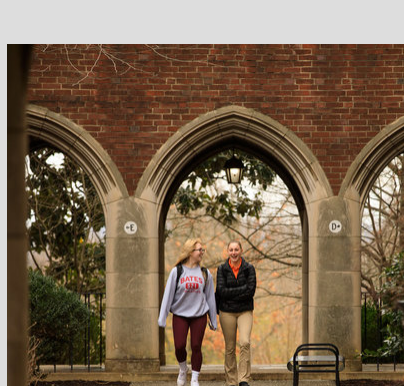


Jim Hamrick Receives Reviewer of the Year Award
